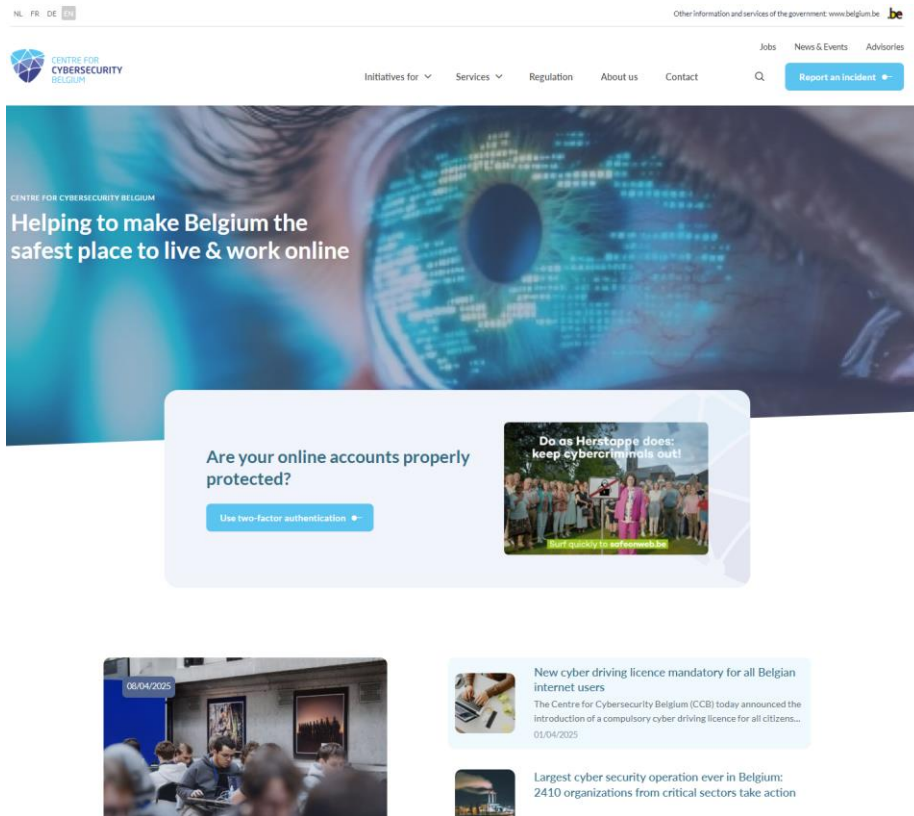

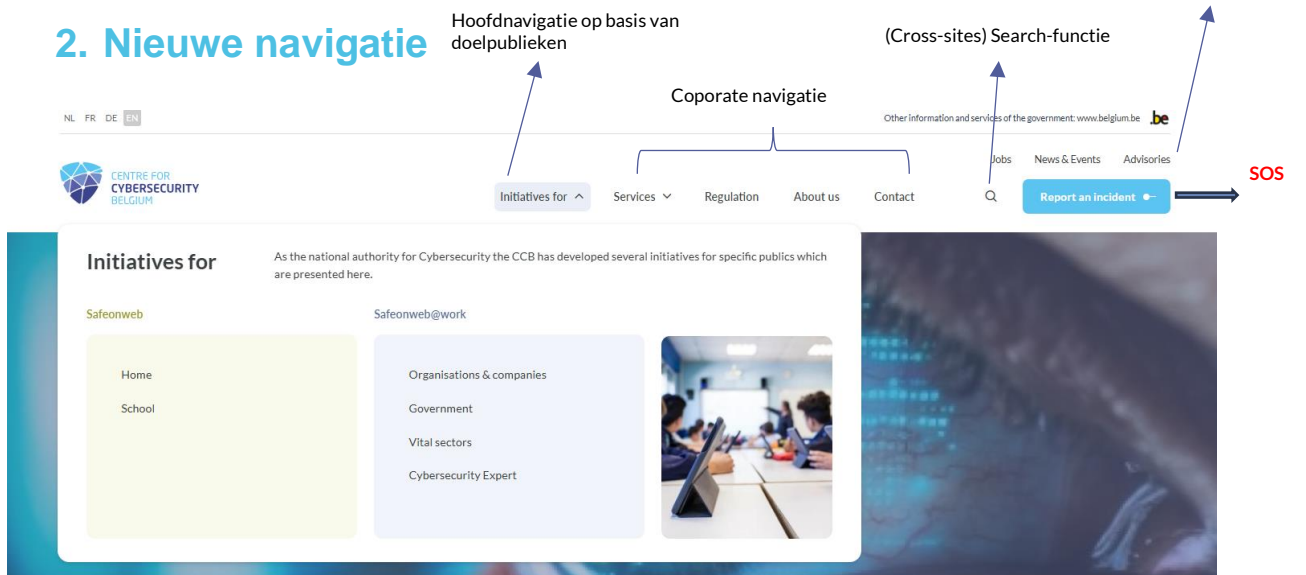


1. Nieuwe " Look & feel "

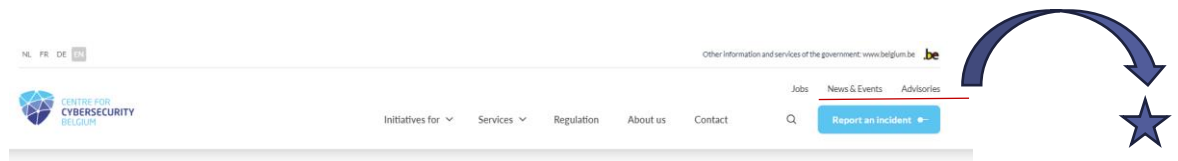
