Organisations first need to register on the Safeonweb@Work platform

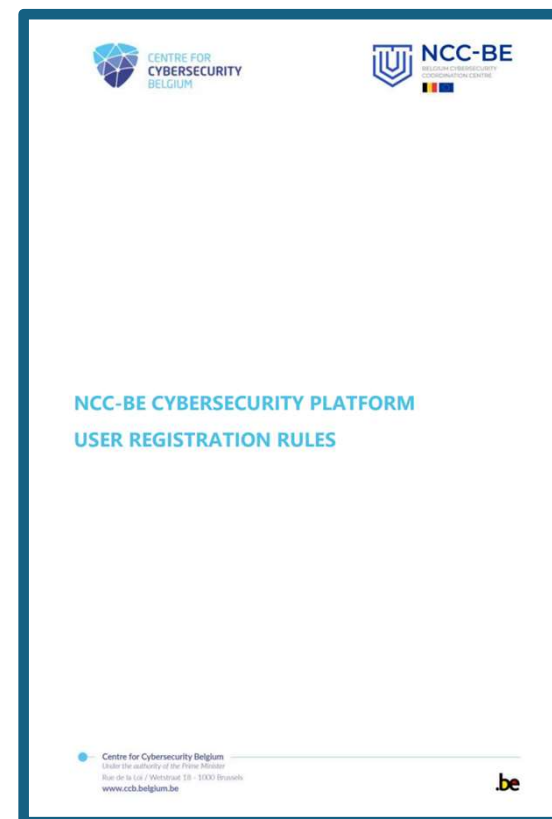


Account Creation and Verification
